Important Bills to contact Legislators

SB638/SB1549- seeking a waiver to include otherwise eligible persons with autism to receive access to programs under the Department of Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities.

SB1145/HB1370- to establish a “money follows the person” procedure for nursing home and community care persons with Medicaid.

SB895 requires Division of Mental Retardation Services to phase in salaries and benefits for direct care staff in determining payments to service providers

SB828/HB2090- allow more beds to be open to people on the waiting list.

SB277/HB938- Voting, bill requires photo ID for Voting, concern is how it effects individuals with disabilities

SB1662/HB1186- Restraint and Seclusion Bill, to set guidelines for this process

SB907/HB374- Due Process Legislation, reform the special education due process proceedings.

SB461/HB2073-Diastat Administration, allowing a volunteer to administer seizure medication besides a school nurse.

SB48/HB477- Class Size and Students with Disabilities, develop a weight class formula for servicing those eligible for special education services.
